

VILLAGE BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF GRAND VIEW-ON-HUDSON
February 10, 2015

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Lynn at 7:30 P.M. and opened the floor for public comment.

Janice Kurzweil was before the Board and asked that an exception made for Corolla Dost to have a bed and breakfast. Village Attorney explained that exceptions to the law cannot be granted for an illegal use and if it was granted to Ms. Dost everyone in the Village would be able to have the same advantage. Trustee Whitney said that she felt the Board should have a review of the zoning law to see if changes should be made. Further discussion was held regarding this matter.

Deputy Mayor Abrams made a motion to approve the warrant as presented by the Village Clerk/Treasurer. The motion was seconded by Trustee Bell and was carried with a vote of 5 ayes and 0 nays.

Jonathan Bell said that he would like to confer with Deputy Mayor Abrams regarding the filming law before reporting to the Board. Trustee Bell said that he will give a report at the March Village Board Meeting.

Mayor Lynn said that he had nothing new to report.

Discussion was held by the Board regarding the terminus of the shared-use path off the new Tappan Zee Bridge onto Cornelison Street in South Nyack.

Deputy Mayor Abrams commented on the snow removal on the side streets and he feels that the snow plowing is being done satisfactorily. He said that the snow removal has not been done on the sidewalks along River Road. Deputy Mayor Abrams asked that a letter be sent out to remind residents they must clean the sidewalks.

Trustee Whitney said at the last meeting she reported that the Village had received a draft letter of agreement from FEMA for \$4,888,000, which she feels is close to what the final agreement will be.

Trustee Lattes discussed the April Board Meeting which is set for April 14th. Trustee Lattes said that she would not be available.

Trustee Lattes said that when she returned home tonight that some of the garbage was not picked up. She asked the Village Clerk to call the carter and tell them that some of the bulk and kitchen garbage was not picked up.

Trustee Bell reported that last month he had expected people from South Nyack to come to our Village Board Meeting but the meeting was being held in South Nyack on the same date. They are having another meeting on the 24th at South Nyack Village Hall about the terminus of the shared-use path from the Tappan Zee Bridge. Trustee Bell said that Judge Tirana had expressed a desire to have some input from the Grand View regarding this subject.

Trustee Bell made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Trustee Whitney and so carried with a vote of 5 ayes and 0 nays.
